*As we enter into the month of November and we prepare to give thanks for all of God’s wondrous blessings, you are asking yourself, “What do I have to be grateful for? What have I done with my time this year? The year has come and is quickly slipping away! Have I accomplished everything I set out to do at the beginning of the year? Was I able to check off items on my personal and spiritual “To-Do-List”? Have I dealt with opposition and duress from those I believed loved and supported me?” Does it seem that for every step you take forward, you fall backwards two steps? Are you weary, weak and worn and under the impression that if it has not taken place by now, it never will? Let me encourage you to hold on! Do not be weary in well doing. Do not throw in the towel! Do not give in! Do not give up! And do not quit! Why, because God’s Word is faithful and true. It changes not! He said in “Due Season” you will reap if you faint not!*

*The race is not given to the swift or to the strong. But to the one who endures to the end! If God has given you a vision, stand and believe that He will give provision! Our time table is not like God’s time table. Our concept of time is not like His! Fret not, He will complete the work He has started in you! Be confident of this one thing! (Philippians 1:6) If things are not moving as quickly as you thought they should, go back and reassess the process. Seek the face of God. Acknowledge Him every step of the way. Write the vision plainly that you and others may read it and run with it! (Habakkuk 2:2) Make each step a bite-size step so it is manageable and also attainable. Consistently check off your completed items to give you a sense of accomplishment and pride and to encourage you to diligently move to the next task. Celebrate! Rejoice over the little things on the journey even though you have not made it to your destination YET! Do you know what that is called? It is Radical Faith!*

*What does “radical” really mean? Dictionary.com defines “radical” as drastic, excessive in opinion, belief, or action, extreme, fanatical, or immoderate. In other words, it’s not the normal everyday way of thinking or acting about something you strongly believe. And “faith” is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Faith is definitely the opposite of fear. God did not give you a spirit of fear but of love, power and of a sound mind. (II Timothy 1:7) So when you put those two things together, you’re bound to shake up the foundation underneath all those safe and cautious Christians. They will not move on what they cannot see! But when you know deep down in your sanctified soul that God gave you the Vision, and you can see it plainly with the spiritual eye, then you can believe it and ultimately achieve it!*

*You cannot give in to the trick of the enemy! He wants you to give up! He wants you to feel like you are a failure! He wants you to feel like you are worthless and useless! He wants you to feel like you are incapable! He wants you to feel like you are not qualified! And He wants you to feel like God made a mistake by entrusting you with this assignment! Hold on People of God, let me encourage you and also remind you that you are fearfully and wonderfully made! (Psalms 139:14) You are who God says you are! You can do what God says you can do! And you can have what God says you can have!*

*So get up, look up and reach up! The sky is the limit to what you can have! If you can’t move forward, don’t go backwards, don’t go to the left or to the right, stand still and mark time and wait for your marching orders from God to proceed to your purpose and your destiny! You can have it! Stand on His promise that He is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that you ask or think, according to the power that worketh in you! (Ephesians 3:20).*
