Do not bring any of that into 2015. Why? Because the past is the past!

It doesn't matter that you feel you missed the mark in 2014! It doesn't matter that your marriage didn't work out, your child is strung out on drugs, you didn't get the job you just knew you had landed, your best friend no longer communicates with you, you lost your house to foreclosure, your car was repossessed, your brother or sister, niece or nephew was senselessly shot down in cold blood, the doctor has given you a bad medical report, your loved one died and left you all alone and vulnerable, you didn't get accepted into the university you really wanted to attend, you went places you knew you should not go, you said things that were not becoming of a Christian, you did things in the dark you would never want anyone to find out about, and you did those ungodly things with someone you shouldn't have been with in the first place, you're not happy in the mental or physical state you're in, you didn't attend worship service faithfully and regularly like you know you should, you didn't pay your tithes and your free will offering because you felt you couldn't afford to, you didn't volunteer or agree to serve in ministry at your local church, or you just can't seem to get your relationship right with God. We serve a God of another chance – not just a second chance!
