As we are steadily stirring forward in 2016, I am believing, declaring and decreeing that 2016 will be my best year yet and that I will receive all that God has for me. Look at the scripture, though there seems evidently a climax here, expressive of more and more importunity, each of these terms used presents what we desire of God in a different light. We ask for what we wish; we seek for what we miss; we knock for that from which we feel ourselves shut out. The following is representative of the actions that you need to perform in order to receive all that God has for you. Whatever you need, God's got it! But there is something that you must do in order to receive.

Ask For What You Wish – Definition: *to try to get by using words; request:*

We know that our God is omniscient. He knows all! But the idea here is for you and I to humble ourselves and ask for the things we desire. Not only must you ask, but you must be sure that you are in perfect position to receive. I recall when my children reached a certain age that I informed them I was no longer going to shower them with things, but that they now had to earn it or ask for it. We love our children so much and often times spoil them by constantly giving them what they want and not allowing them to come to us with their needs and desires or even do something wonderful that earns them a special treat. I believe that God feels the same way at times. He wants us to humble ourselves and plug into the power source that can supply all of our need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus!

Seek For What You Miss - Definition: *to go in search or quest of; to seek the truth.*

Anyone remember the parable of the woman and the lost coin? She discovered she had lost one of her coins in the house. Notice if you will the events that take place: she loses one piece of silver - (Point of Realization). She lights a candle - (Point of Illumination). She sweeps the house - (Point of Preparation). She seeks diligently - (Point of Determination). She finds it - (Point of Restoration). She calls her friends and neighbors together - (Point of Communication). And lastly, she rejoices - (Point of Celebration). What are you seeking for? Wealth, position and prestige, fashion or fame? (Matthew 6:33) admonishes us to seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness; and all these things will be added unto you. So may I suggest to you on today to seek God. And when you do, know that He is a rewarder of them who diligently seek him!

Knock For That From Which You Feel Yourself Shut Out - Definition: *to strike a sounding blow with the fist, knuckles, or anything hard, especially on a door, window, or the like, as in seeking admittance, calling attention, or giving a signal:*

The way to knock on the door for admittance into the presence of God is with your praise! Praise is your weapon. It confuses the enemy. But the best thing it does is summons God to inhabit your praise. That's right! He comes down and sits right in your midst when you offer up true praise. The bible says that God is a Spirit and those who worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and in Truth! When you knock with your praise, He comes in and sups with you and you with him.

So when you begin to feel shut out from God, when you begin to feel cut off from God, when you begin to feel disconnected from God, begin to give Him your best praise and watch His spirit penetrate the atmosphere.

Ask, Seek and Knock because what God has for you, it is for you.
